ACADEMICS

Class XII Results. It is heartening to note that the school recorded a sharp increase of 29.7 points in API in comparison with the last year. This academic year, the API of class XII is 161.70 with Priya Kumari scoring 97.2 % from Humanities stream. We express our heartfelt gratitude to the management and the society for honouring her with a cash reward and a kindle. Motivation can move mountains and we are certain that with this kind of motivation there will be many more students scoring above 95%. Priyanshu Kumar scored 90.8 % from the Science Stream. Sonali Patro topped the Commerce stream with 88%.

Class X Results. API of class X during this academic session is 209.10 with Shalini Raj scoring 97.6 % and securing 1st position in girl's merit list of Jabalpur. Astha Dhama, Arun kumar Kushwaha and Astha Singh scored above 95% of marks.

TEACHERS' EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMMES:
